

Immigration and Visa Checklist

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION



Use this checklist to make sure you have completed all necessary immigration and visa requirements.

- The first step to becoming a student at St. Edward's is to apply for admission. Once you are accepted, you'll receive a university acceptance packet that will include a welcome letter from the Office of International Education and will outline the information relevant to your immigration status while studying at St. Edward's.
- After you receive your acceptance packet, you must send in your \$150 nonrefundable enrollment deposit to guarantee your space in the incoming class of students. By paying the enrollment deposit and submitting the required financial documents, you can register for housing — required of all freshmen — and orientation. At this time, the university will also issue your I-20.
- If you are an F-1 student who is studying for the first time in the United States, an I-20 will be sent once St. Edward's receives your enrollment deposit. If you are an F-1 transfer student, you will receive an I-20 from St. Edward's once you have been released in SEVIS by your previous institution.
- To apply for your visa, you must make an appointment with the U.S. Consulate in your area. Be sure to present your I-20, along with your acceptance letter and financial documentation, to the consulate.
