

New Freshmen Application Checklist

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION



To be considered for admission at St. Edward's University, you'll need to complete an application and send all the items listed below. Use this checklist to track your progress.

Put yourself in the best position to receive scholarships and financial aid — complete your application packet before the Feb. 1 Priority Deadline.

Date Sent/Requested

Official High School Transcript(s)

Request that your guidance counselor send us a current high school transcript. (If you haven't graduated yet, make sure your transcript shows your grades and class rank at least through your junior year.) An official transcript bears the high school's official seal and is sent in an envelope that is to be opened only by St. Edward's.

Test Scores

Send in your SAT or ACT composite score, including the applicable writing test. If you have scores from both tests sent to us, we'll consider the one that best enhances your application. Scores will be accepted in one of two forms: directly from the testing agency or printed as part of the official high school transcript.

Application Fee

The \$45 application fee can be paid by credit card, cashier's check or personal check. This fee is waived for students who apply by Dec. 15 for fall admission. Also, St. Edward's accepts official fee waivers and requests for waivers from high school counselors.

Essay

One of the most important parts of your application is the essay you will write. You'll find a list of essay questions to choose from on the application. Your essay must be at least 500 words and can be included with your application or sent later.

Academic Recommendation

Request a recommendation from a counselor or a teacher of an academic subject. Your recommender may write a separate letter or use the [Academic Recommendation Form](#). One academic recommendation is required. Additional recommendations — including those from teachers of non-academic subjects, coaches, parents and family friends — are also welcome.

Optional

- **Supplemental Materials** — Include work that represents a special accomplishment or interest, like an art project, creative writing samples or research papers. Be sure to send copies, as materials will not be returned.
