

We welcome visitors to our hilltop campus throughout the year. Check your calendar and choose the visit opportunity that's best for you.

### Campus Tours

Our campus walking tours are led by current students and last about an hour and 15 minutes. Spring tours are at 9:30 a.m., noon and 2 p.m. on Monday and Friday, and 9:30 a.m. and 2 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday. Tours include a look inside academic buildings, the student center, athletic facilities and one residence hall. To reserve a place on a tour, [schedule a campus tour online](#). While you're here, you can meet with an admission counselor to ask questions and help us get to know you. To schedule an appointment with a counselor, call our office at 512-448-8500 or 800-555-0164. If your schedule does not allow you to visit campus when guided tours are given, you may take a self-guided tour by cell phone. Maps with instructions are available in the Admission Office, at the Ragsdale Center information desk, and at the kiosk next to visitor parking. You may also print the [tour map \(PDF\)](#) at home and bring it with you. The tour narrates a walk around campus, so you may listen to it at home, but it will be most useful for campus visitors.

### Group Tours

Groups interested in visiting campus are welcome to call our office at 1-800-555-0164 to discuss available dates. Guided group tours are available for high school students only from September through April and must be scheduled at least two weeks in advance. Elementary and middle school groups are welcome to visit campus using our self-guided audio tour. Please call our office for more information.

### Group Programs During the School Year

Several times a year, we accommodate guests in full-day or half-day programs.

- Scholars Snapshot, Feb. 19–20 – An invitation-only program for students selected as scholarship winners. The program includes a dinner with awards, campus tour, class observations and optional overnight stay.
- Spring Break Showcase, March 12–16 – This week we'll offer campus tours at 9:30 a.m., noon and 2 p.m. Monday through Friday. Each tour will be followed by a snack break featuring treats from neighborhood and alumni-owned businesses. If you'd like to see our Residential Village, stay for a short tour of this freshman and upperclassman housing option at 11 a.m., 1:30 p.m. or 3:30 p.m. After your visit, leave your car on campus and catch the bus to the nearby shops, restaurants and live music on South Congress Avenue — we'll provide the parking and the free bus pass. - Scholars Summit, March 23 and April 2 – A daylong program focused on advanced academic opportunities for scholarship winners. By invitation.
- Picture Yourself at St. Edward's Day, April 14 – A daytime program for seniors who have been accepted to St. Edward's and want to visit campus one more time before choosing a college. By invitation.
- Junior Snapshot, March 21 – An introduction to life at St. Edward's for high school juniors. Tour campus, learn about the admission and financial aid process, and meet students and faculty.

Reservations for these programs are required and open five to six weeks before the program date. All programs are free.

### Individual Visits During the School Year

High school seniors are welcome to schedule a more in-depth visit to experience life as a St. Edward's student. With at least two weeks' advance notice, we can arrange for you to attend a class, meet with a professor, eat in the dining hall and stay the night with a student host. You can also take a tour and meet with an admission counselor. These visits are offered from September to April.
