Dear athletic directors and coaches:

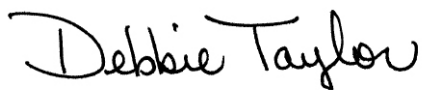
Welcome to St. Edward's University. We strive to guarantee a pleasant experience for visitors to our campus, as well as to the city of Austin.

Athletic Training Services

St. Edward's University staff and student athletic trainers will be available to assist visiting athletic trainers and teams. Licensed and/or certified athletic trainers are welcome to use any of the equipment in our facilities. If your team is not traveling with a licensed and/or certified athletic trainer, please send a note accompanying any athlete requiring the use of training equipment.

- Special accommodations for athletic training

Our athletic training facilities are located between the men's and women's locker room in the Recreation and Convocation Center. Typically, the facilities open two hours prior to the scheduled start time of the competition, unless other arrangements are made prior to the competition date.

Heat packs, hot and cold whirlpools, electric stimulation and ultrasound are all available in our training facilities. In addition, visiting teams are supplied with the following (depending on the sport):

- Water and cups
- Wound-care kit
- Splint bag
- Injury ice and bags
- Water bottles
- Crutches
- Bench towels

Campus Map & Directions

From I-35 South

Take the Woodward Street Exit and make a right on Woodward. There are two entrances from Woodward on your right: Theatre Pass and Andre Drive.

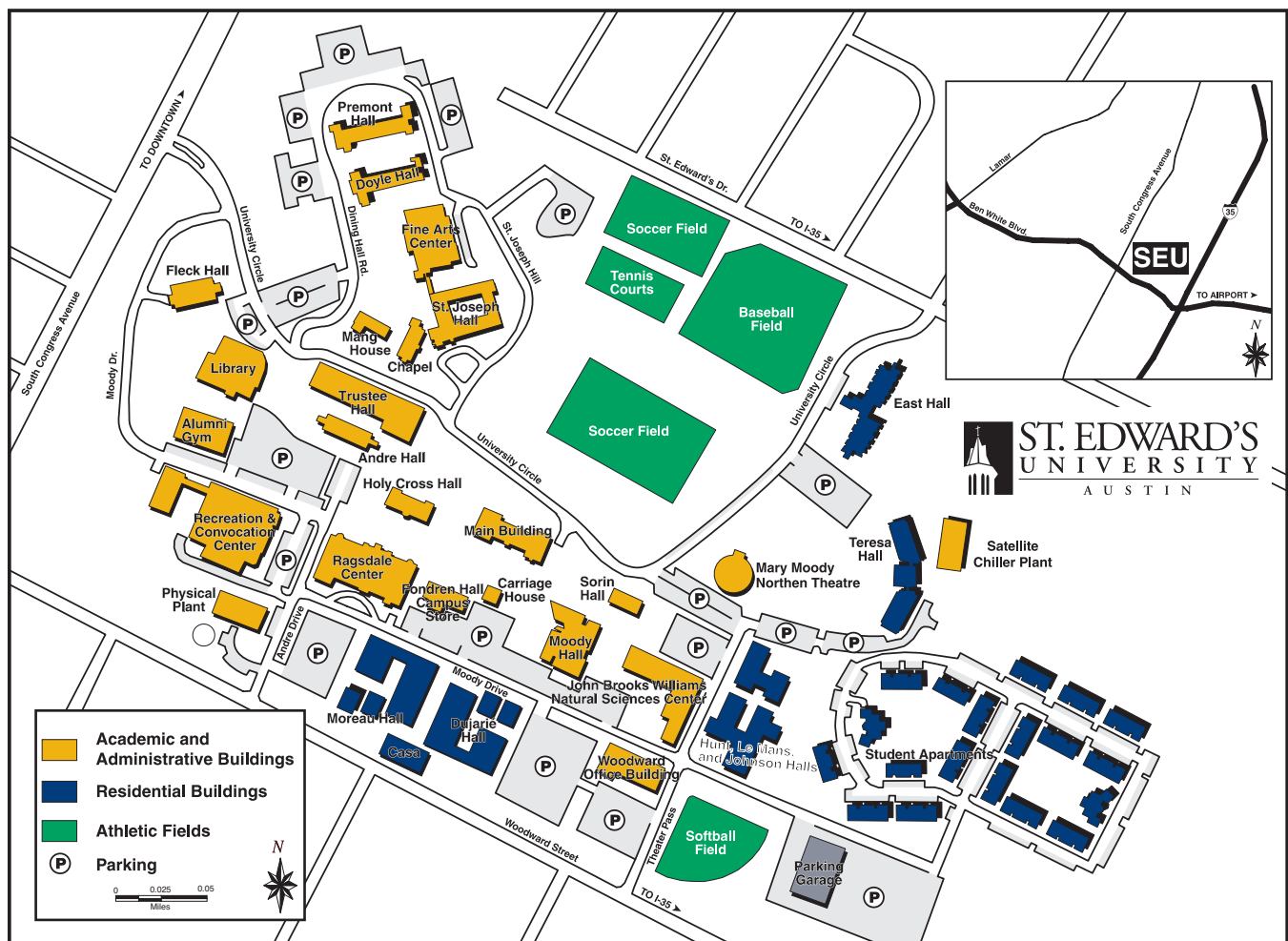
From I-35 North

Exit Ben White and remain on the access road until you reach Woodward Street. Turn left on Woodward. There are two entrances from Woodward on your right: Theatre Pass and Andre Drive.

From Mopac South

Exit Loop 360. Remain on 360 as it changes to Highway 71 East. Take the South Congress Avenue exit, turning left onto South Congress. Continue past Woodward Street to the main campus entrance, which is on the right at 3001 South Congress.

Note that there is **no parking** on campus for buses or vans that do not normally fit in a regular parking space. All buses must park on St. Edward's Drive, just north of the baseball field. If you travel in vans, you will receive a parking pass to place in your window as you drop off your student-athletes at their sporting venue.
