

ALPHA SIGMA LAMBDA SCHOLARSHIPS (Deadline –December 15, 2008)

Alpha Sigma Lambda Honor Society for adult students is offering a total of \$2500 in academic achievement scholarships to students 24 years of age or older who have a minimum of 18 graded credit hours at SEU prior to the fall 2008 semester, with a GPA of at least 3.2. The amount of each award will be determined by the scholarship committee, based on the number and merit of the applications. Undergraduate and graduate students are welcome to apply. Undergraduate and graduate applications will be evaluated separately.

These scholarships will be awarded according to the following criteria:

- A. Financial need (30%) based on need as demonstrated in an application essay and in both the SEU Financial Award Letter and the SEU Student Aid Report.
- B. Scholarship (40%) based on the transcript, scholarly activities/awards, and two references, **at least one of which must be written by a faculty member**. The other may be a professional or community service reference. **Remember that faculty members will be off for the holidays, so please request your reference as soon as possible.**
- C. Communication skills (20%) based on the written application and essay.
- D. Past and present leadership in community or university service (10%) based on the listing and description of leadership activities.

Applications and supporting materials must be turned in together and by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 15th at the office of Dr. Paula Marks, Holy Cross Hall, Room #307.

***APPLICATIONS THAT ARE INCOMPLETE CANNOT BE CONSIDERED.**

Please note that the following are required for consideration for the scholarships and must be turned in by the student as a complete packet:

- Application form with essay
- One copy of student's SEU transcript (Does not need to be official)
- Two written references
- Copies of both the SEU Financial Aid Award Letter and the SEU Student Aid Report

Awards will be made by January 12th the start of the spring semester. Applications are available in the Office of Student Financial Services, on the Student Financial Services website, outside the New College Office, in the Center for Academic Progress (CAP), and outside the office of Dr. Paula Marks, Alpha Sigma Lambda Co-Advisor, Holy Cross Hall, Room #307.
